

Win 03 Pergamon (Full Day)



Tour Programme:

We will meet the visitors at the lobby of the hotel or İzmir port. Soon after, we will set off driving on Çanakkale-İzmir highway to the capital of Pergamon kingdom, Bergama. After approximately one and a half hours trip we will reach to Bergama. This city, the summer of A.D. 334, became important with the Alexander the Great crossing the Çanakkale coming to Anatolia who put his booties in the Pergamon castle then for Aegean region become a start for a cultural period. In the period of Eumenes II a library 200.000 books is built. Pergamines parchment which is accounted a most important revolution was used first at Pergamon. Zeus Altar whose remnants exhibited in Berlin museum today has the most importance. We will begin the Pergamon tour from the *ACROPOLIS* with 335 meter high we will see the most perpendicular museum of the world and upright centre remnants. Then we will visit a wonderful Roman temple, *SERAPIS TEMPLE* also known as *KIZILAVLU (RED BASILICA)* which is dedicated to Serapis who is Egyptian god. After that we will take a break for lunch.. In the end we will visit *ASCLEPION* where the first psychological treatment had been used and which was dedicated to the God of Health, Asclepius.
